The Playhouse toddler room has been operating since 1975 as a beautiful space for children to grow and explore. Our two toddler rooms are each staffed with a Lead Educator and Assistant and supported by full-time float staff throughout the day.

Orientation

We're delighted to offer a complimentary 3-day orientation program to help your little one (and you!) settle into our toddler room.

Love and care for your toddler

We know each child is unique and our staff spend time getting to know every personality to develop that special bond. We take the initiative to discover their interests and preferences. Each child has the opportunity for a day sleep, which is voluntary. We make sure every toddler receives plenty of love and care each day.

Life as a Playhouse toddler

At this tender age, children start to become aware of the world around them and form relationships. Separation anxiety can be quite normal, and we work closely with families to support them through this transition. Our educators are experts and use a range of strategies to support children's growth and learning. This includes role modelling, talking about appropriate behaviour and praising positive behaviour.



Toddler learning activities

We incorporate the following activities to foster holistic learning and development in our toddler rooms:

- Lots of new things in a safe and supportive environment
- Parallel play (playing next to each other)
- Musical activities
- Tactile activities, such as finger painting, body painting and water play
- Activities around the early stages of toileting
- Experiences that challenge their thinking
